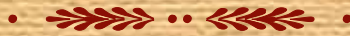

# FAR, FAR AWAY

POSTCARDS FROM PRE-REVOLUTIONARY UKRAINE

**AN AMAZING COLLECTION  
OF UKRAINIAN POSTCARDS  
FROM THE TSARIST TIMES.**



Most of the postcards are from around 1900 – 1913 with the oldest dating back to 1896. The 134 photographs showcase Ukrainian castles, buildings, monuments and churches from cities covering the major regions of Ukraine as they were in Tsarist times.

Some of these edifices were destroyed and no longer exist. The display, therefore, provides an impression of how cities in the nineteenth century Ukraine appeared.

The postcards are framed, singly or in groups of two or three, along with explanatory text.

In the last two years the *Far, Far Away* exhibit has travelled to Regina, Toronto, Calgary, Saskatoon, Yorkton and New York.

This is the last time this exhibit will be available for viewing by the public.
